**CONSTITUTION AND RULES.**

1.—The League shall be called "THE GLASGOW AND DISTRICT CHURCHES' BADMINTON LEAGUE." All Churches and kindred Associations shall be eligible for membership. The Annual Subscription of each Club shall be ten shillings (10/-) payable not later than the 31st July.

2.—The objects of the League shall be to foster and encourage the game of Badminton, and to do everything necessary or desirable for the promotion of the interests of the game among Christian Agencies.

3.—The League shall be managed by an Executive Committee, which shall consist of two representatives of each Club in membership of the League.

4.—The following Office-Bearers shall be elected annually:—Hon. President, President, Secretary, and Treasurer, not necessarily representatives of Clubs in the League.

5.—The following Office-Bearers shall be elected annually from the Executive Committee: Vice-President, Assistant Secretary, and two Auditors.

6.—The President be only eligible to hold office for three sessions.

7.—A Standing Committee shall be elected annually to select teams for representative matches.

8.—At the A.G.M. of the League, which shall



be held in the month of May, alterations to the Constitution and Rules shall be considered, provided fourteen days' notice has been given to the Secretary. A two-thirds' majority shall carry a motion, each Club shall only have two votes on all matters, and the Chairman shall have a casting vote, or at a specially summoned meeting, provided 14 days' notice has been given to all clubs.

9.—The Balance Sheet presented at the A.G.M. by the Treasurer shall have been passed by the Auditors.

10.—The Executive Committee shall conduct all business of the League. It shall have power to deal with any player or Club violating the Rules. Members of the Committee shall retire if their Clubs are involved, but they shall be entitled to be heard on the subject; fifteen shall form a quorum provided each Division be represented, and a bare majority shall carry a motion.

11.—Each Club shall play home and away matches with every Club in the League. Points shall be awarded as follows:—Two points for a win, one point for a draw.

12.—All matches must be for four couples mixed doubles, and to be played as in American Tournaments, each couple to play one game of fifteen acés (all games to change at eight acés) with each couple of the opponents. If after two and a half hours' play the game is unfinished the

result of the games played will be taken as the final score, and points awarded accordingly, but should the home Club receive an extension of time, the Clubs can by mutual agreement complete the games.

13.—Clubs failing to play as in Rule 11 lose the points, and defaulting Club be held liable for half expenses; the maximum half expenses to be four shillings.

14.—All matches shall be played according to the laws of the game as approved by the Scottish Badminton Union, with the exception that the minimum size of the court be 40 ft. in length and 18 ft. 6 ins. in breadth.

15.—Clubs tying for League Championships will play off as the Committee decide.

16.—The Club winning the Second Division League Championship will be promoted to First Division, and the Club at foot of First Division will be relegated to the Second Division; this to apply to other Divisions.

17.—All players taking part in League games must be registered three clear days before playing in a match. No registration form will be accepted unless accompanied by a fee of six-pence; registrations are valid for one season.

18.—The home and away Clubs shall each have an Umpire who shall umpire the games. Linesmen are essential for each game. The Clubs to make their own arrangements regarding same.

19.—Play in all matches must commence not later than thirty minutes after recognised starting time. Clubs failing to observe will forfeit the points.

20.—In all League matches the Captains of the teams shall hand to the Umpire, and to each other, before the start of the game, a list of their respective teams, an exact copy of which, with the result of the match and games, signed by the Captains and the Umpire, must be sent by the home Club to reach the League Secretary not later than two days after the match.

21.—League fixtures can only be altered with the sanction of the League Secretary, provided seven days' notice has been given, stating reasons. In cases of emergency, where seven days' notice has been found impossible, a written statement from the Management of the Church, stating that the hall is not available, will be deemed sufficient reason for the postponement of the fixture.

22.—Any Club playing a player under an assumed name, an unregistered player, or an ineligible player, will lose the game and be fined two points in addition.

23.—(a) A player taking part in two matches for a Club in this League shall be bound to that Club unless officially transferred.

(b) No Club shall sign a player of another Club, who has played in two games for that

Club, unless the said Club agree to transfer. In transfer an official form must be used.

(c) All transfers must meet with the approval of the Executive Committee.

(d) No player be transferred after 31st December of each playing season.

24.—No players can be registered after 31st January each playing season.

25.—Visiting teams must conform to any local rules in force with the home team; home Captains must explain these rules to the visiting team before the match commences.

26.—Protests on points of play must be formally intimated to the Captain of the competing Club in the presence of the Umpires (who shall grant to the protesting Club a receipt for same) before leaving the hall.

27.—All protests must be lodged in writing by the protesting Club with the League Secretary, accompanied by a deposit of 10/-, and a verbatim copy of protest, detailing the nature and date of infringement, sent in a registered letter to the Secretary of the Club protested against, all within three days after the match. No protest will be considered bearing a later date of post than the third day after the match. The deposit may be forfeited should the Committee consider the protest trivial, groundless or informally lodged, and Clubs may be further held responsible for expenses incurred.

28.—The home Club must provide four regulation shuttlecocks; if a less number than this is

provided, and the Umpire considers that they are unplayable, and the game cannot go on, the home Club loses both points.

29.—All League games must commence not later than two and a half hours before the recognised closing time of the hall.

30.—Clubs failing to be represented at the Executive meetings be fined one shilling for first offence, and two shillings for any other meeting they fail to attend during the season.

31.—Should any question arise which is not provided for by the Constitution and Rules, the Committee shall have power to determine same.

32.—On a requisition signed by half the representatives of the Clubs in the League a special meeting must be called.

33.—In the event of a Club failing to fulfil an arranged League fixture without the sanction of the League Secretary, such Club shall be held liable for expenses. The Committee shall have power to inflict a fine on Clubs failing to fulfil their arranged fixtures.

34.—A Committee of seven (with powers to add further members if desired) shall be elected annually to make all arrangements for tournaments and to be responsible for carrying through same.

35.—The President, Secretary and Treasurer shall be *ex-officio* members of all committees.

36.—The names and addresses of Match Secretary, two League representatives, and

location of hall shall be notified in writing to the League Secretary with the payment of annual subscription. Any change in above should be intimated at once.

37.—That a handbook be published with the Constitution and Rules, League fixtures, etc., each Club to be responsible for twelve copies of same.

38.—The Secretary of home Club must write Secretaries of visiting Clubs, who must receive notice not later than three clear days before the match, explaining the location of the hall and the best way of reaching same.

**Recommendation.**

The Executive Committee of the League recommends that each Club have a copy of the laws of the game, as approved by the Scottish Badminton Union, in their hall on the nights of the matches.

Postal Orders sent in payment of Registration and Tournament Fees, Dance Tickets, etc., should be made payable to Glasgow and District Churches' Badminton League and crossed "& Co."

**IMPORTANT.**

The Executive Committee will meet in the Alexandra Parade Methodist Halls, Millburn Street, at Alexandra Parade, on the second Friday of each month, at 7-45 p.m. prompt. Clubs will be notified of any change in this arrangement.

**LEAGUE GOSSIP.**

The Divisional Championships were won by Wellfield (1st Div.), Duntocher (2nd Div.), and Martyrs' Guild (3rd Div.).

We offer our heartiest congratulations to these Clubs on their splendid performance.

Mr. J. Telfer Sinclair relinquished his chains of office at our A.G.M. We are greatly indebted to Mr. Sinclair for the time and labour he expended during his three years as President of our League.
