CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The tournament will be conducted under the rules of the Scottish Badminton Union including the prohibition of doping which tests may be carried out.

Players must be Registered Players of a Club Affiliated to Glasgow Churches Badminton Association and be ready to play from 9.30pm on the 19th & 20th February 2022. In Doubles events, partners must be Registered with a club in the Association but this can be different clubs.

All the matches will be the best of three games to 21 with setting as appropriate.

Entry fees will be £12.00 per person.

Entry fee for any player entering three adult events will be £30.00

There will be consolation competitions for events 1,2,3,4 & 5, if the event is a straight knockout. If the event is played in sections there will be no consolation event. If you do not wish to be included in any of the consolation events please inform the control desk.

Please note that there will be no catering available at the Cockburn Centre.

Notes for Online Entry

If you have not used the online entry system before, you require to go to the www.tournamentsoftware.com or www.alltournaments.co.uk site, "Sign Up" (for free) and follow the instructions. These are fairly easy to follow but if you have any problems the following is a summary of what is required:-

Sign Up, set up a user name and password along with your details, name address, date of birth, gender, email address, etc. Once you have registered you will be asked to "activate" your account by clicking on the "activation" link on an email that tournamentsoftware or alltournaments sends to your email address.

When your account is activated you should "login" and edit your "Profile" by inputting the required information in the different fields of the topics "Personal Details", "Contact Details", which requires at least one phone number, and "Sport Details", which requires you to select your sport (Badminton) and you must enter a "Strength" in singles and doubles. Any "Strength" can be selected say "A". This is used in other countries where the tournaments have different "Strengths" for events within their tournaments. Your member id. can be found on the BadmintonScotland website or, if you do not have one, leave it blank and the online entry system will allocate a member id. to your entry but you have to enter the club/school name through which you are affiliated to your National body or type "Individual" if you are affiliated as an individual.

This information is stored as your profile and used each time you enter a tournament online.

Once you have registered and are logged in on www.tournamentsoftware.com , or www.alltournaments.co.uk go to the tournament and follow the online entry instructions to enter the tournament and play online.
